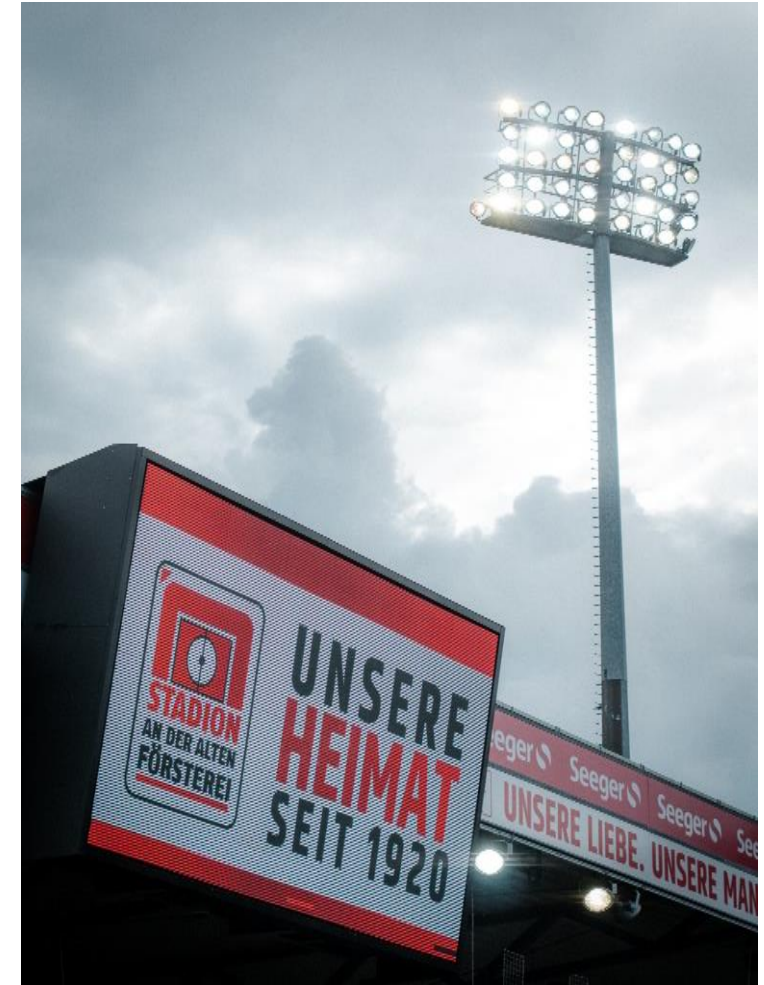

MEDIA AND WORKSPACES



For print and online journalists, 50 seats are available in the press sector of the Stadion An der Alten Försterei. Please note that the taking of photos, sound recordings and videos from the press gallery is not permitted.

Photographers receive their gray identification vests at the media gate against a deposit (e.g. press card). Pitchside photography is permitted behind the two goal lines and on the touchline from the goal line to the line of the 18 yard box. Photography is not permitted in any other area (see point 5 in the stadium plan).

MEDIA AND WORKSPACES

The mixed zone will be available to accredited journalists in the 2023/24 season.

The press conference in the presence of both coaches will take place after the game in the PK room.



ACCREDITATION AND PARKING PERMIT



Accreditation for home games of 1. FC Union Berlin is only possible through the club's media department. To do so, please email the completed DFL accreditation form to Benjamin Blumeier. If you need a parking ticket, you can apply for one using the form. Please note that only fully completed applications can be considered.

The completed form must be received by us no later than **five working days before the match day**. In the case of a weekend match day, the deadline expires on Monday of the respective week at 15:00, for midweek match days it expires on the previous Tuesday at 15:00. We cannot consider accreditation requests outside of the deadline. Please note that accreditations can only be granted to adult and full-time media representatives.

INTERNET/WIFI

Free WiFi is available to media representatives both in the press conference room and in the press box. The current access information will be posted in the press conference room on the day of the match. All seats in the press box are also equipped with network connections. If required, LAN cables can be provided.



ACCREDITATION ISSUE AND DIRECTIONS



Accreditations can be collected from the reception (to the right of the main entrance of the main stand) from around 120 minutes before the start of the game. The red media gate takes you to the press seats and the photo area inside. The media gate is located to the left of the main stand.

The Alte Försterei can be easily reached by public transport. From the S-Bahn station Köpenick (S3) it is a 10-15 minute walk along the embankment to the stadium. All media representatives can access the stadium by car via Rudolf-Rühl-Allee where parking lot P4 (see stadium map) is situated.
